RENVILLE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2021

SEPTEMBER 7, 2021

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon, Commissioner Arnold Langehaug and Commissioner William Stanley.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, gave the Board an update for his department. They will begin mowing County roads next week. The Air Force is working on graveling several missile site roads in the County. Sean had no concerns regarding his 2022 budget.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. August payroll and officers reports were reviewed and filed. Travel requests were approved as presented.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug that the minutes of August 2021 be approved as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Deputy Auditor, Robin Stark, spoke to the Board about the expansion project at the Mouse River Park. She is applying for grant monies from Garrison Diversion. The project will add camping sites to the southeast side of the Park. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Langehaug to approve the expansion project and submit a grant application to Garrison Diversion. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. The project will also be partially funded by gaming funds received from Kenmare Vet's Gaming donations.

Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Stanley to have the monthly oil revenue received from the State receipted to the Highway Fund for the remainder of 2021. The funding will revert to the General Fund in January 2022. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Stanley to open the coal bids. A bid was received from Minot Coal in the amount of \$144.50 per ton for the 2021-2022 heating season. Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Stanley to accept the bid from Minot Coal. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. This bid reflects a \$8.00 per ton increase from last season.

Lyndsay Ulrickson, Souris Basin Planning Council, has asked the County to name a city representative for the SBPC Board. The City of Sherwood was the most recent city named. The Board will look at the request at their September 21st meeting.

County Sheriff, Roger Hutchinson, met with the Board. He thanked them for approving his 2022 departmental budget. He asked the Board to consider two changes to his budget. He would like to add \$500 to the Tires line item and \$2,000 to the Equipment line item. The Board will review his request at the next meeting. Sheriff Hutchinson has been invited to Washington, DC along with other "border state" sheriffs. They will be discussing the recent reduction to the Stonegarden Grant program. The trip is at no cost to Sheriff Hutchinson or the County.

NDSU Interim District Director, Shana Forster and County Agent Bethany Gates, met with the Board to discuss the additional 2 mill levy allowance that will expire in 2024. The law allows 2 mills to be levied for the County Agent's budget and an approved vote allows an

additional 2 mills. The office has levied an average of 3.17 mills over the last 10 years and they would like to continue to have the option of the additional available mills. Moved by Comm. Langehaug, second by Comm. Stanley to submit the question of voter approved additional levy authority to be voted on at the June 2022 Primary election. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

SEPTEMBER 21, 2021

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon and and Commissioner William Stanley. Commissioner Arnold Langehaug was absent.

Road Supervisor, Sean Mattern, met with the Board. They are busy mowing County roads and have also mulched trees at the Grano crossing. One township has requested to have some trees mulched by the County. They will also be picking rock on County Road #2.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. Officers reports were reviewed and filed. Travel requests were approved as presented.

Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Marmon to amend the 9-1-1 budget, Dispatch Service to \$50,500.00 for the 2021 budget year. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. The payment to Bottineau County in 2021 covered August thru December of 2019 and all of 2020.

Sheriff Roger Hutchinson visited with the Board. He asked if he could donate some equipment that his department can no longer use to the Glenburn Fire Department. The Board was fine with that.

At 10:00 a.m. the Board held the public preliminary budget hearing. No one appeared before the Board. The Board discussed the Airport budget request of \$98,000.00 for 2022. They would like to talk to Mike Nehring concerning the expenses and revenues for the Airport for

2020. Auditor Pollman will speak to Mike and give him an appointment for the October 7th Board meeting.

Kristy Titus, DES Coordinator, asked the Board if she could conduct a table top exercise for the Courthouse employees. It would be a mandatory meeting. The exercise would take about an hour and a half. The Courthouse would be closed to the public so that all employees can attend the training. She will check on a date that will work for everyone. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Marmon to close the courthouse on the approved date so that all employees can attend the training. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Kristy also discussed the County's current Burn Policy. Some counties in the State are leaving their burn policies in place through the winter. The Board made no decision concerning ending the current burn policy for 2021.

Penny Volosin discussed the need for some sort of animal shelter in the County. She currently traps cats and does have a network in place to rehome them. She does not have a holding facility other than her own personal set up. She had spoken to someone in the city of Berthold and they told her that Ward County has a contract with the Souris Valley Animal Shelter in Minot. Auditor Pollman will contact the shelter in Minot and bring the information back to the Board for discussion.

Moved by Comm. Marmon, second by Comm. Stanley to name Sherwood City the city of representation to the Souris Basin Planning Council. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

The Board discussed the 2022 budget. Moved by Comm. Marmon, second by Comm. Stanley to approve \$3,000.00 annual salary for the Coroner. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Moved by Comm. Stanley to increase the Sheriff's budget line item for Tires by \$500.00 and the Equipment line item by \$2,000.00. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Moved by Comm. Stanley, second by Comm. Marmon to add an additional \$1,530.00 to the Auditor's annual salary for 2022. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.
