RENVILLE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2023

JANUARY 3, 2023

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon, Commissioner Jamee Hansen and Commissioner Andy Gates.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, met with the Board. All of the sanding trucks are broke down. Comm. Gates has found a truck in Minnesota. It is a 2012 IH 7600 for \$53,900.00. It has a sander and a blade. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Marmon to purchase the truck. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Sean discussed the possibility of getting an extended warranty for the motorgrader that would have been traded in this year. The Board and Sean have decided to not trade a motorgrader this year. The closing time for the motorgrader/maintenance position is Friday, January 6th. Comm. Gates will sit in on the interviews with Sean.

Ryan Ackerman and Sabrina Herrmann, Ackerman-Estvold Engineering, met with the Board. Ryan gave the Board a report on the progress of the Mouse River Plan. The bridge at Mouse River Park will be replaced this summer.

The Board reviewed a request from HDR Engineers for approval of permits from the County for the bridge replacement at the Mouse River Park. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to approve the permitting. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

At 10:00 a.m., the time set to open insurance bids, Comm. Hansen moved that the bid on hand be opened, second by Comm. Gates. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. It was noted that the bid, from Citizen State Agency, was received in a timely manner. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen that the bid of Citizens Agency be accepted for inland marine, general liability, and auto insurance. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Agents Mike Nehring and Mason Nehring were present for the bid opening.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates that the minutes of December 2022 be approved as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. December payroll and officers reports were reviewed and filed.

Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to approve 2022 budget amendments to the Sheriff Reserve Fund in the amount of \$25,000.00 and the Park Fund in the amount of \$32,000.00. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen that the quarterly reports for the period ended December 31, 2022 be approved and accepted. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Ted Keller and Scott Suedmeier, General Roofing and Construction, met with the Board to discuss the repairs to the front steps and walk way at the front of the Courthouse. Chad Schmidt, Custodian, also surveyed the project with the Board and Ted and Scott. The Board felt

that the project was not completed to the bid specifications and was not willing to pay for the project in full. After discussing what they would like to see addressed this spring, Comm. Hansen moved to pay 60% of the invoice now and the remainder when work is completed to the Board's requirements, second by Comm. Gates. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to approve an overtime rate of \$50.00 per hour for the Sheriff's Department for all services. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Auditor Pollman presented the cost bill for the 2022 General Election. The cost per vote was \$11.15. Total number of ballots counted was 906.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to approve the Beer & Liquor licenses for Danny's Bar & Bottle Shop Inc d/b/a Country Mouse Bar for the 2023 calendar year. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

JANUARY 24, 2023

Board convened at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chairman Robert Marmon, Commissioner Jamee Hansen and Commissioner Andy Gates.

Jason Mayfield, Wold Engineering, met with the Board. They discussed the upcoming road project. It will be an overlay of 4 miles north of Mohall on CR#9 and from Glenburn west (including the spur) 3.5 miles to the intersection of Hwy 83. The County will use funds from HB1066 (Operation Prairie Dog) in the amount of \$1,473,736.50. Total cost of the project is estimated at \$1,585,500.00. The County will pay for the difference out of Road & Bridge funds.

Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to hold the bid opening for the project on February 21, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Sean Mattern, Road Supervisor, met with the Board. The new truck is in service and working great. He will place signs on the two bridges that needed different load limits posted. He has hired Brady Brooks to work out of the Tolley Shop. He will start February 1, 2023. Sean discussed overtime pay versus accruing compensation time. Moved by Comm. Hansen, second by Comm. Gates to limit the accrual of comp time to 40 hours. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. Once an employee has accumulated 40 hours of comp time, they will need to use it before they can bank any more.

Kristy Titus, DES Coordinator, discussed holding an exercise for Courthouse employees. She will coordinate with the employees to choose a date when everyone can participate. The building would close for an hour while the exercise is taking place.

Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Hansen to remove and discard a chair (#1660) from the Sheriff's office. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Correspondence addressed to the Board's attention was reviewed and discussed. January payroll and officers reports were reviewed and filed. Travel requests were approved as presented.

That the Board of Renville County Commissioners resolves to keep the Renville


County Clerk of Courts' office a county office for the following reasons:
