

RENVILLE COUNTY PARK BOARD PROCEEDINGS

APRIL 7, 2026

RENVILLE COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Board convened at 8:15 a.m. Present: Park Board Commissioners Keith Degenstein, Diana Krause, Jamee Hansen, Rick Haman and Andy Gates. Also present: County Auditor LeAnn Pollman.

Jack Pung (Pungo's LLC) will start at the South Comfort station today.

Angie Sundahl met with the Board to ask permission to erect a sign for the All Faith's Chapel at the Park. Moved by Comm. Krause, second by Comm. Gates to approve the request. The sign is being made by Precision Farm Parts in Sherwood. Angie will talk to Gerry Steen to see to the placement of the sign.

Moved by Comm. Krause, second by Comm. Gates to approve the minutes from March 24, 2026 as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Keith Degenstein has been looking into the fish cleaning station equipment.

Gerry Steen will take care of updating the berm at the sanitation station. Gerry mentioned the softball diamond fence could use some repairs or possible replacement. The last estimate he had for replacing the fencing was \$50,000.00.

Vera Jones presented her ideas for the C-Store. She asked if the Board would consider purchasing the following equipment that is owned by her: chest freezer, coffee maker, small fridge, malt machine and display case. She also owns a convection oven. The Board discussed several options. Moved by Comm. Krause, second by Comm. Hansen to purchase all the equipment listed except for the convection oven. The board will reconsider the purchase of the oven later this fall. They would like to see how the season plays out for Vera.

Vera asked about the LeFleur games that are in the C-Store. Auditor Pollman will contact LeFleur's. She also mentioned getting a slushy machine. The Board took no action on that item. Auditor Pollman will get Vera a copy of the lease and it will be addressed at the next meeting.

Julie Vetter, HR Consultant, asked the Board to approve hourly rates for Jody Sampson at \$21.50/hour and the P/T seasonal help to start at \$18.00/hour. Moved by Comm. Krause, second by Comm. Haman to approve the hourly wages for the 2026 season. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.
