

RENVILLE COUNTY PARK BOARD PROCEEDINGS  
MAY 5, 2026  
RENVILLE COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Board convened at 8:30 a.m. Present: Park Board Commissioners Keith Degenstein, Diana Krause, Jamee Hansen, Rick Haman and Andy Gates. Also present: Vera Jones and County Auditor LeAnn Pollman.

Moved by Comm. Haman, second by Comm. Hansen to approve the minutes from April 7, 2026 as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye.

Online reservations are going well. \$98,271.70 has been collected in camping fees as of April 30, 2026.

Jack Pung (Pungo's LLC) and Matt Johnson Plumbing have finished the renovations in the South Comfort station. Auditor Pollman will request gaming funds for the cost of the project from Vet's Gaming in Kenmare. The Board discussed replacing the toilets in the South Comfort station this fall. The North Comfort station may need some renovations this fall also.

The Board discussed the lease agreement for the C-store with Vera Jones. Moved by Comm. Gates, second by Comm. Haman to approve the lease with Vera setting her hours this season, the Board will see how the season goes and revisit the hours that the C-store is open this fall. Motion carried by unanimous vote of aye. The lease is \$100.00 per month for the season.

Comm. Degenstein found an ice cream dipping cabinet thru CCR Supply in Bismarck. It has been ordered. The cost is \$1,933.75.

Gerry Steen stated they have removed the freezer from the C-store and cleaned it. The freezer is working.

Comm. Degenstein had asked ND&T Services to give the Board an estimate on cement stabilization for the parking area between the bar and C-store and the roadway leading into said parking lot. The total would be \$65,000.00. The Board discussed the proposal and will ask Farden Construction for an estimate.

Auditor Pollman was in contact with Jeff Brusseau of JB Surfaces. They will be sealing the pickleball court and installing the net as soon as the weather warms up.

The Board asked Gerry to remove the handicapped accessible signs from the C-store & bar parking lot. The area is not legally a handicapped accessible parking spot.

Tom Witteman is working on an estimate for camping pedestal upgrades.

Keith mentioned the need for gravel on the road to the church and in the South campground. Comm. Gates will talk to Sean Mattern to deliver some recycled material and gravel to the park.

The Board discussed the AED for the South campground and the need for WiFi at the Park. Victoria has been working with SRT for the WiFi. The Auditor's office will talk to Justine Hanson about the AED.

Gerry asked about the "No wake" buoys. Victoria will research and order two. Keith mentioned that the sign on Hwy 5 and CR #3 was not in good shape. Gerry will measure it and the Auditor's office will research and get an estimate for a new sign. Diana asked about getting a Fire Index sign at the Park. Diana will talk to Kristy Titus and David Stark about the sign.

The Board would like to review the Park ordinances. Auditor Pollman will get those to the Board.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 a.m.
