

MOUSE RIVER PARK RULES

Please read these rules carefully!

RESERVATIONS & CHECK IN/CHECK OUT:

- Reservations can be made online:
<https://app.fireflyreservations.com/reserve/property/MouseRiverPark>
- Credit card to confirm all reservations.
- Check in time 3:00 pm.
- Check out time 12:00 pm.
- Check in upon arrival at the park office or the FireFly Kiosk to secure a valid vehicle or camping permit. Contact Park Caretaker for availability for early check in/late check out times.
- A paid permit is required for all overnight camping & must be displayed on site (persons parking in reserved areas WILL be forced to relocate to another site)
- Campers without reservations MUST check with Park Caretaker or reserve online before setting up at a vacant site. (This is to ensure that they are not in a reserved area, should the reserved sign be missing.)

PETS:

- We understand that pets are part of the family and are welcome in our park.
- All pets must be leashed at all times when outside of your RV and should never be left unattended.
- No pets allowed in the public restrooms, the bar/c-store.
- Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after your pets promptly and properly. Pet waste must be bagged and disposed of in an appropriate waste container.
- Aggressive or excessively noisy pets may be asked to leave the park at the discretion of management.
- Please be considerate of other guests and ensure that your pet's behavior does not disturb or pose a threat to others.

GENERAL:

- Adults are responsible for the conduct of minors.
- Renville County and its employees are not responsible for any accidents nor your personal property. Please report loss of any property to the proper authorities.
- Cutting or gathering of trees or parts of trees and/or removal of wood from parks and recreation sites is prohibited.
- For Emergencies call 911.
- No Smoking in public buildings or 20 feet from entrances.
- Users will be held liable for any damages to park facilities.
- First District Health requires campers to keep a 10-foot spacing from adjacent campers.

- Camping equipment or setup may not damage the campsite.
- The use of portable kennels and swimming pools must be approved by the park manager. Pools may not exceed six feet in diameter and eight inches in depth.
- Digging of sod, soil, or gravel to accommodate camping or camping equipment is prohibited.

BOAT RAMP/DOCKS:

- No Wake Zone within the park.
- Do not block boat ramps.
- No person may park or leave any watercraft, unattended on courtesy docks located on boat launching ramps unless retrieving or parking the towing vehicle.
- Do not swim around the boat ramps.
- Boat ramp users shall obey posted regulations with regard to loading and unloading of all water craft.

CAMPSITES:

- Do not move fire rings.
- Do not damage picnic table or park equipment.
- Do not move picnic tables from one campsite to another.
- Camping is permitted only at sites or areas designated by the Renville County Park Board and posted by signs and/or marks.
- The unauthorized placement of camping or other items at any campsite without overnight occupancy for the purpose of reserving a designated campsite for future occupancy is prohibited.
- Only ONE RV or Motorhome per sites – tents are allowed on your campsite for immediate family under age 18 only. Camping fees apply to all other tents.
- Do not leave trash, cigarette butts, oil/grease, can, bottles etc. behind on your campsite. **Violators will be charged a \$100 fee.**

PARK EQUIPMENT/TOOLS:

- All tools and equipment used with staff permission only.

FIREARMS/WEAPONS/FIREWORKS:

- Firearms, bows & arrows, slingshots, BB Guns & other weapons are prohibited
- Fireworks are only allowed July 3rd – July 5, and only at the designated area (Softball Diamonds)

NOISE:

- Quiet hours 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM
- Generator usage restricted from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM

- Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs who disturb others, will be asked to leave the park.
- Excessive noise and quiet hours are enforced. Campers are here to enjoy the peace and quiet of the park.
- Barking dogs must be quieted or removed.
- No excessively loud music.

SEWER/GARBAGE:

- Do not release sewage or gray water in the campground other than at the designated dump station.
- All garbage should be placed in a receptacle or dumpster.
- Dumpsters are for household garbage ONLY – no mattresses, furniture, ashes, charcoal, tires, grills or hot items.
- No Private Dumping in the Dumpsters.

CAMPFIRES:

- Fires shall be confined to designated areas, and shall be contained in fire rings, grills or other facilities designated for this purpose.
- Do not move fire rings
- All fires must be attended by a person 18 years of age or older at all times
- Upon abandonment of the fire, it must be completely extinguished.
- Do not burn garbage or pallets in your fire ring
- Please CLEAN out your firepit before you leave. Your firepit is not a garbage. Any garbage left in your firepit, after your reservation may result in a **\$100.00 fee.**

VEHICLES/ATVS

- Speed Limit is 15 miles per hour and applies to ALL campground roads.
- No person shall operate any vehicle in a careless, negligent or reckless manner so as to endanger any person, property or environmental feature.
- All operators will be expected to obey all posted regulations.
- Please drive carefully and watch out for children.

PUBLIC RESTROOMS/SHOWER HOUSE

- Please clean up after yourself, help keep restrooms clean.
- Do not clean fish, dishes etc. in the restroom.
- Contact the Caretaker if there are any issues with the restroom/shower house.
- Showers are for park patrons ONLY!

ALCOHOL & DRUG POLICY

- Alcohol is allowed. Please drink responsibly.

- Irresponsibly drinking that may be considered a nuisance will not be tolerated and therefore grounds for immediate eviction with no refund and possibly blacklisted.
- Drugs are prohibited on the campground. The use of drugs on the campground may lead to being blacklisted.

CANCELLATIONS

- A full reservation refund will be given less reservation fees if you cancel more than 7 days before your scheduled arrival.
- A 50% refund will be given if you cancel less than 7 days.
- No refunds on early departures
- No refund if you fail to cancel before arrival date. (i.e., a “no-show”)
- Reservations Fees \$3.50 are non-refundable.

SEASONAL CAMPERS:

- Seasonal campers are expected to keep their campsites neat and clean.
- Keep the campsite mowed and maintained to the same degree as the transient campsites.
- No added sheds, deep freezes or other outside storage allowed without prior approval.
- Payments must be paid in FULL by April 15th.
- No sub-leasing of seasonal sites to a third party.
- All personal items must be removed from the campsite end of season. Failure to remove any items will result in a **\$200.00 fee.**
- Signed seasonal camping agreement.
